

Requirements for Gardner Denver products

Scope of Application: Gardner Denver Deutschland GmbH, Bad Neustadt

We aim to provide our customers with a declaration on the contents of our products that goes beyond the legal framework. It will be specified that all substances and packaging that are subject to a prohibition or restriction, will not be used in products and components supplied by Gardner Denver.

Substances that are subject to a restriction must be declared.

Below is an extract of legal prohibitions or restrictions. The requirements must be observed worldwide. The list does not provide a comprehensive overview of national and international legislation regarding prohibited substances, and does not exempt suppliers from inspection and compliance with other legal requirements.

Candidate list / SVHC (Substances of Very High Concern):

The publication of the candidate list triggers extensive obligations with regards to the provision of information in the supplier chain. REACH obliges companies to inform their commercial customers if one of the chemicals in the list is found at more than 0.1 percent.
